Penelope Scholarship

The Montreal Chapter of the Daughters of Penelope (AHEPA Family) is pleased to present its scholarship program for 2010. The \$1000 **Penelope Scholarship** will be awarded on Sunday, May 16, 2010 at the Recognition Awards and Fundraiser cocktail to be held at the Hellenic Community Centre of Montreal, 5757 Wilderton Avenue in Montreal.

Applicants of the Penelope Scholarship may also apply for the Meandros Scholarship for Hellenic Studies if they meet all the requirements; however an applicant can only be awarded one scholarship in the same year.

Applications will be assessed on a grid totalling a maximum of 100 points. A maximum of 80 points will weigh on academic achievement; 10 points on volunteer work and 10 points on the essay. An extra point will be awarded to an applicant that is presently a member of one of the four orders of the Montreal AHEPA Family.

Qualifications

- The applicant must be female
- The applicant must be of Hellenic origin (father, mother or grandparent)
- The applicant must be a Canadian citizen
- The applicant must be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate program in a government accredited university in Quebec
- A minimum grade point average of 75% or equivalent must be achieved for the last two completed semesters as calculated from official transcripts (to be submitted with application)
- a letter of recommendation from an academic instructor must be included
- Letters supporting leadership and volunteer activities or certifying membership in good standing should be submitted where applicable.
- An essay of 500 words, typed, outlining your educational and future goals
- a 3" by 3" headshot of yourself
- submissions may be made in French or English
- completed application must be received by the deadline date: **April 16, 2010**
